

OUR OPINION: the laws and observations in the Torah is to speak to your heart with understanding.
All the laws are beautiful and have meaning - the root of them all boils down to the most important laws that Yeshua said, which are to:

- Love for God (Deuteronomy 6:5): "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your might."
- Love for Neighbor (Leviticus 19:18): "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

If every person would list the laws as they found them, the lists would all differ.

DISCLAIMER - This list given here is just a guideline as we found it - but it is not without error. We don't see all of them as laws, but rather a combination of laws, observations, guidelines, teachings and prophecies.

We found some laws for example that is not mentioned in the jewish 613 laws and found some of the jewish 613 laws that they listed as misleading.

For example :

- why is the 7th commandment of Adultery not listed in 613?

- why is the law of "not adding or removing from Torah" not in 613? Deuteronomy 4:2 and Deuteronomy 12:32

18	All	Observation	Worship	Worshipping YHWH	Gen 4:26	After Adam and Eve had children again, they obviously taught them about the past, and people learned about YHWH. Not like Adam and Eve who took it for granted when they walked with YHWH. Learning about YHWH the Creator and Father, the love drives you to want to worship Him.
19	All	Laws	Food	Clean and Unclean	Gen 7:2, Gen 8:20	Noah only offered clean animals - and it smelled so soothing to YHWH that He made a promise (even before the rainbow) to never curse the ground again because of man - even though man's heart is evil from youth. In Genesis 6 YHWH says He will establish a covenant with Noah because he walked with YHWH and was righteous. Obviously YHWH taught Noah and even his forefathers (Enoch, etc) more commands, especially about what is clean and unclean.

21	All	Prophecy	Tribes & Tongues	Scattered people and languages	Gen 11:8	YHWH scattered the people from Babel who were of one language, with one purpose to serve themselves. In Zephaniah 3:9 it is prophesied that YHWH will give His people a pure chosen language to call on His Name with one accord.
22	All	Laws	Tithe	10th of Spoils	Gen 14:17-24	Tithing is mentioned as if it was a normal thing and understood. The people knew about tithing long before Moses' laws. It is a matter of the heart that wants to give.

So not just to instruct your children, but appoint and give charge to about His Promises, Instructions and Laws. This same word, Sava is used in for the very 1st command YHWH gave to Adam - He SAVA/commanded the man, of every tree they may eat except..
26	All	Observation	Righteousness	Be Righteous	Gen 18:19	Do the right thing, rule right. The word Righteous is the same word for Justice & Truth.
27	Ishmael	Prophecy	Muslim Nation	Ishmael will increase greatly	Gen 21:18	YHWH meets Hagar in the desert, comforts and motivates her with a promise - that Ishmael will be a great nation too. Ishmaels' generation represents the flesh (from the decision Sarah made) versus Isaac that represents the spirit (YHWH's intervention)
28	All	Observation	Tests	Trials and Temptations	Gen 22:1	We all have to go through trial & tests, be put to the test. Interestingly Yeshua's prayer of lead us not into temptation - is a way of saying, do not give us over to our temptations.. But deliver us from evil. Evil is another word for not fulfilling your purpose. For that we have to be tested.
29	Jacob	Prophecy	Brothers	Two Nations	Gen 25:23	Even though Jacob tricked his dad Isaac, it was promised by YHWH that Jacob would take the leadership role in the end.
30	All	Observation	Tithe	Thankful	Gen 28:20-22	Jacob commits to giving a tenth to YHWH - how or where does he give? Because this is way before there was a Temple or Levites. So many times we find ourselves in this position - we WANT to give. Later when YHWH gives the Torah to Israel, He gives 3 ways that you can give your tithe. You can use your tithe for the Festival when going on the pilgrimage, you can give it to the poor, and you make sure the Levites are taken care of - so giving to the Levites - who are poor by default, as they are instructed to belong to YHWH and they have nothing, their lives are dedicated to the Temple. Today we do not have the poor Levites or the Temple. But many of our brothers and sisters are poor and in need today. There are many places in Scripture where YHWH does command to take care of your neighbors, widows and orphans. Those who are needy are the heart of YHWH. Yeshua even says, if you take care of the stranger, you are entertaining angels and actually taking care of Yeshua himself!
31	Men	Observation	Relationships	Husband to love their wives	Gen 29:31	YHWH sees those who are unloved and rejected.
32	All	Observation	Marriage	Multiple wives	Gen 30:1	Rachael and Leah envied each other and wrestled in this one marriage. Abrahams' wife Sarah and her maid also struggled, even though the maid wasn't legally married. Later in Scripture, we will see YHWH giving instructions that a man is not to marry two sisters at the same time
33	All	Observation	Food	Sinew / Tendon of animal	Gen 32:33	Avoid eating the sinew/tendon parts of animal. Scriptures says here that Israel adopted this as a rule.
34	All	Laws	Cleansing	Be clean before YHWH	Gen 35:2; Exo 19:10	Cleanse yourself when approaching YHWH or His place of worship
35	All	Observation	Dreams	YHWH Communicates	Gen 37:5	Even before Joseph, there have already been 3 times where YHWH talked to someone in dreams - Abimelech for Sarah, Jacob about the rams, Laban about Jacob. This is obviously a great way for YHWH to communicate with us. But considering the story of Joseph, one should be careful to tell the dreams to everyone. Consider Deut 13 about "dreamer of dreams"... if your dreams could lead people away from YHWH!
36	All	Observation	Dreams	Interpretation and Witness	Gen 41:16,32	Joseph admits that only YHWH can give the meaning of dreams. Dreaming a dream twice symbolises a Witness - so it proves that it is true as well.
37	All	Prophecy	Tribes & Tongues	Nations	Gen 49	Each tribe is described according to the sons' character, but also what YHWH have laid out for each so they can work together, to protect each other.
38	All	Observation	Names	Tribe/sons names	Exodus 1:1	Shemot - our names are important and have meaning.
39	All	Laws	About YHWH	YHWH's Name	Exo 3:15, 20:2	YHWH gives 3 things to identify Him forever : 1) I AM 2) YHWH Elohim 3) Ancestor Covenant

40	All	Laws	Circumcision	Covenant of blood	Exo 4:25-26	This episode highlights Moses's failure in covenant duty, Zipporah's decisive action to save him, and the importance of circumcision for covenant participation, averting judgment and resolves Moses's status, making him fit to represent YHWH, demonstrating that personal holiness precedes national leadership
41	Devil	Prophecy	Curse	Snake / Dragon	Exo 7:9	In Genesis 3 ha-satan appears as a snake, which can also be translated as a dragon. Here we see the snakes of Pharaoh been swallowed up as a prophecy. And in Revelation 12:9 the dragon/old serpent and his followers been thrown out.
42	All	Prophecy	Curse	Water and Blood	Exo 7:17	Water to blood. Water is the purification and blood is retribution and judgment. This sign/plague will be repeated in Revelation 16:3-4 where rivers turn to blood and Rev 8:8 a third part of the sea turned into blood.
43	All	Prophecy	Curse	Clean and Unclean	Exo 8:2	Frogs represent unclean spirits as per Rev 16:13
44	All	Prophecy	Curse	Death	Exo 8:16	Dust to gnats represents dust from where men came from, and gnats are death in the air. So this rather refers back to creation and sin that brings death.
45	All	Prophecy	Curse	Sickness	Exo 8:21	Flies represent annoyance and distraction, and with it brings ailments. That is what ha-satan uses, anything that causes distraction and deceivment.
46	All	Prophecy	Curse	Pestilence	Exo 9:3	Pestilence and death comes through diseases (a plague outbreak) and is the punishment for sin committed with the body (eyes, mouth by speaking, skin, sexual sin, etc)
47	All	Prophecy	Curse	Skin diseases	Exo 9:8	Ash represents repentance done willingly, or else judgement by fire. Boils represent anger or resentment.. Literally boiling from inside out. Rev 16:2 mentions painful sores on the people who take the mark of the beast.

From the beginning to the end, we have representation on the importance of the firstborn. This prophecies to Yeshua. Rev 1:17 & 22:13 "I am the 'Aleph' and the 'Taw', the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last."
52	All	Laws	YHWH Moedim : Festival / Days	Passover : Watching the barley and wheat when ripe, getting ready for Spring harvests	Exo 9:31; 12:2	Marking new beginnings, the start of a year. When the wheat/barley is in Aviv (green in the ear). New Month also translated as New Moon. So with the new moon in the month when the barley is green and close for harvest time. The barley ripens on the length of the days & temperature. YHWHs' calendar is thus based on sun and moon together. The barley ripens around Spring Equinox time in the northern hemisphere. Spring Equinox + Earth/Barley Aviv + Moon = 3 witnesses. Gen 1:14 "let the lights in the sky mark religious festivals (moedim), days and years"
53	All	Laws	YHWH Moedim : Festival / Days	Passover : Lamb	Exo 12:3-6	Take care of one-year-old male lamb/goat with no defects, that can be shared among families, until the 14th day of the first month.
